THE REVELATION of Jesus Christ

THE Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave Him to show His servants—things which must shortly take place. And He sent and signified it by His angel to His servant John, who bore witness to the word of Jesus and to the testimony of Jesus which he who reads and hears the words of this
