of Jesus Christ


THE Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave Him to show His servants—things which must shortly take place. And He sent and signified it by His angel to His servant John 3:32 • Rev. 22:6

9 I, John, both* your brother and companion in the tribulation, persecution, and famine which came upon me, and I was on the island that is called Patmos for the word of God and for the testimony of Jesus Christ.

10 I was in the Spirit on the Lord's Day, and I heard a voice as of a trumpet saying, "I am the Alpha and the Omega, the first and the last, the beginning and the end."


