

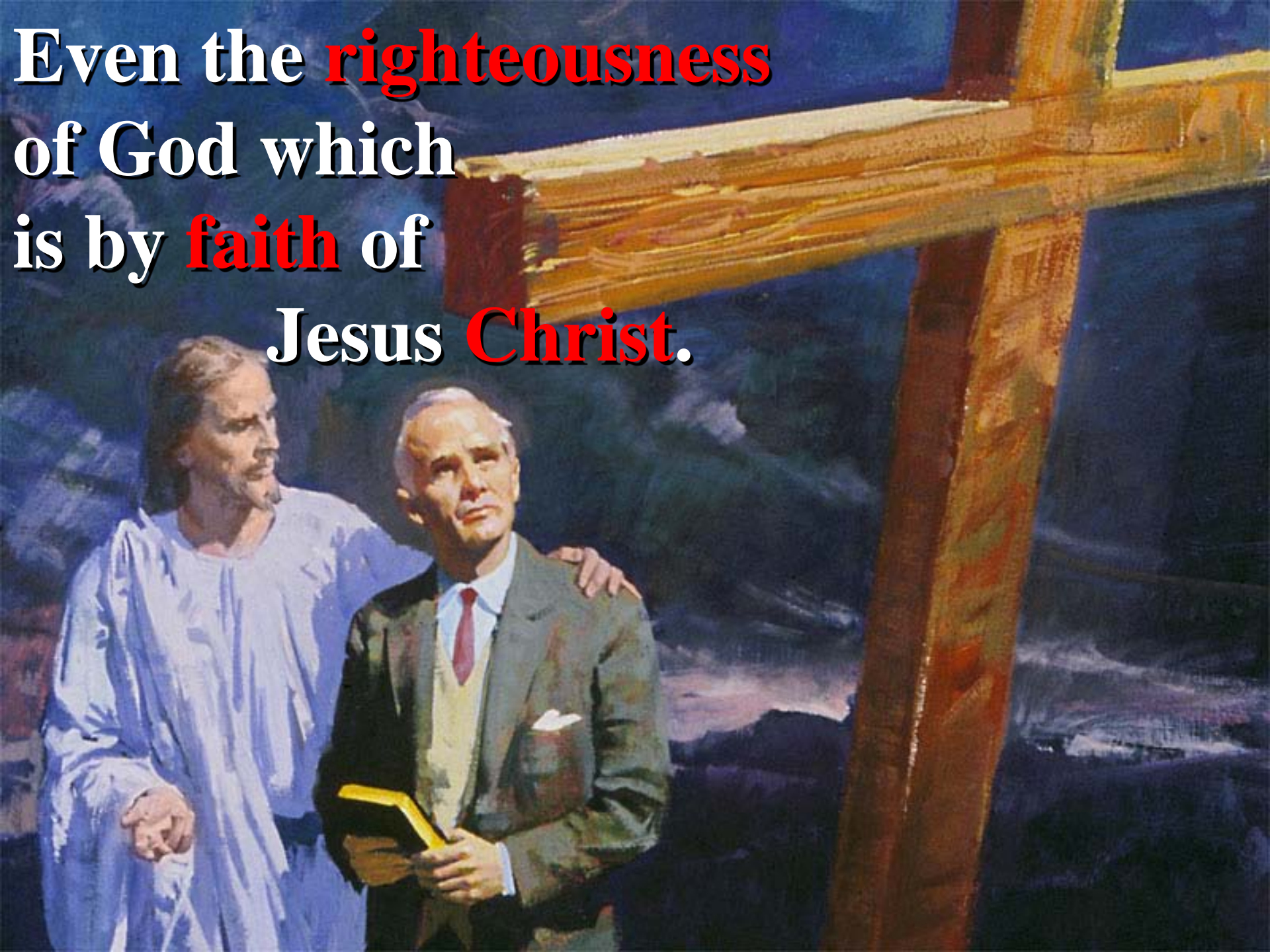



that are **past**.


**4. What must

1 Thessalonians 4:3-12 (1735)



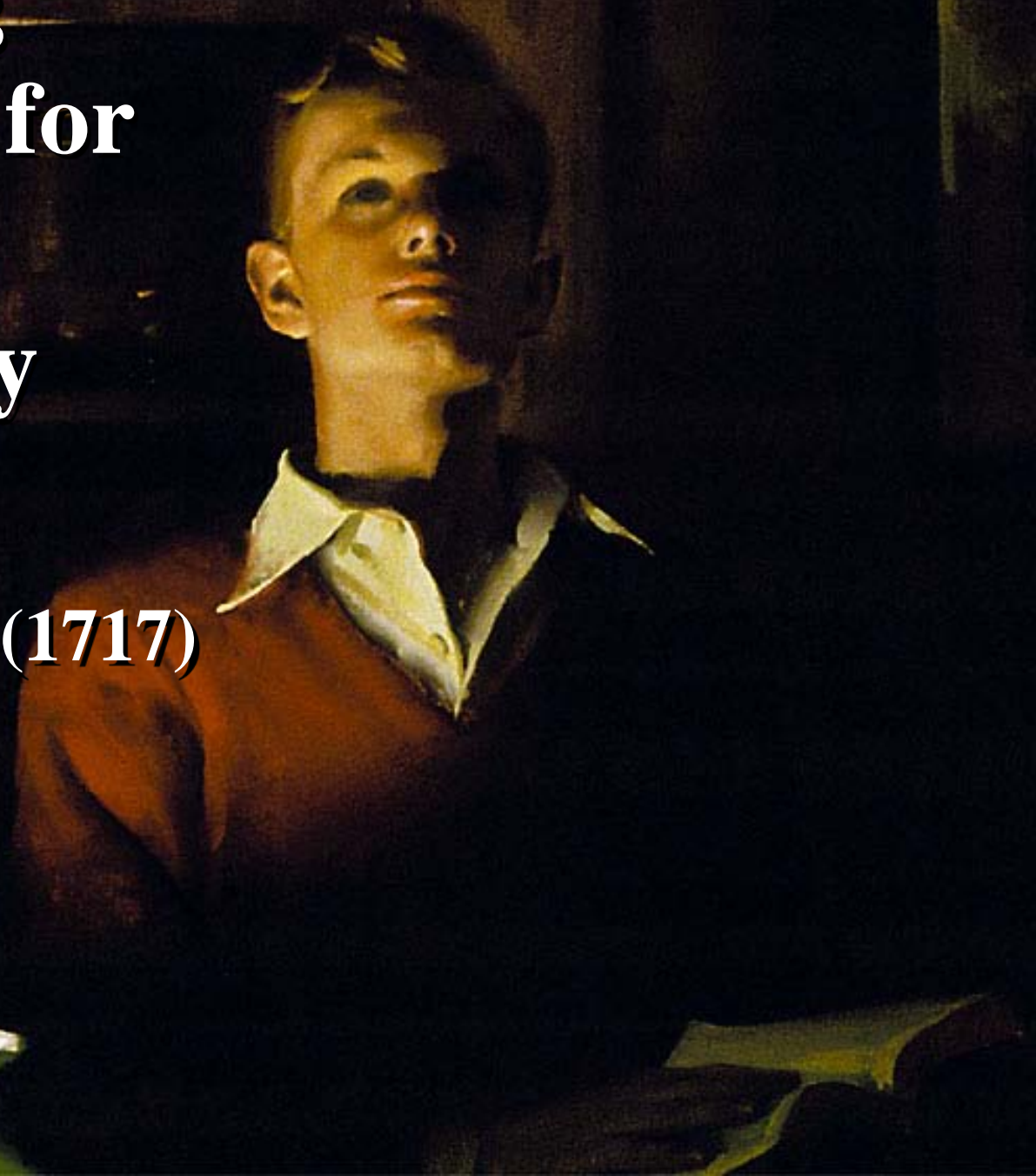
That everyone

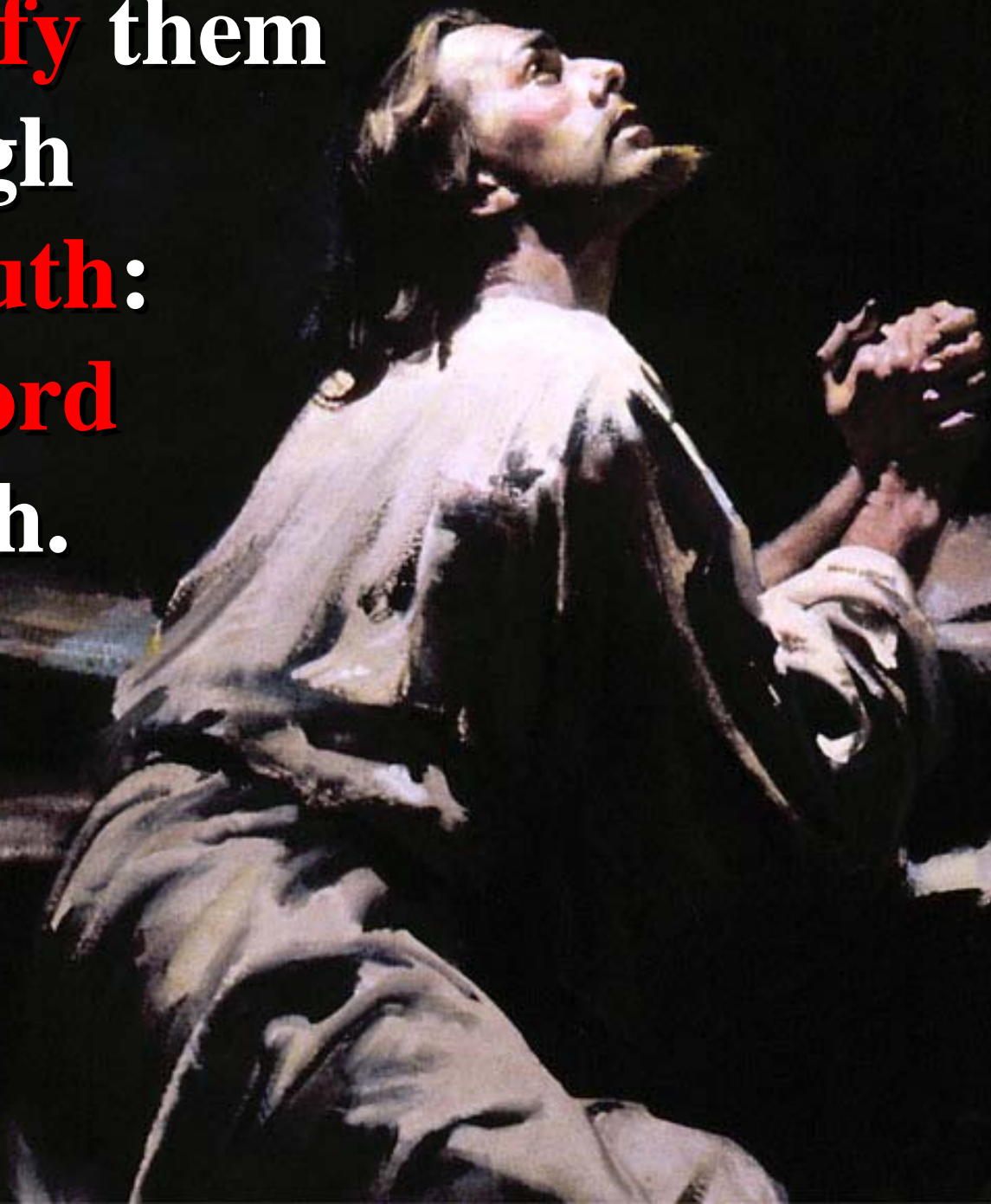
Till we **all** come in

**Christ.**


# 8. How is sanctification accomplished?

is truth.

Who **delivered**  
us from so  
great a death,  
and  
doth **deliver**,  
in whom we  
trust that

**yet deliver** us.



# How the Bible presents it:

a. **Justification** is conversion.

It delivers us from sin's *penalty*.

b. **Sanctification** is victorious living.

It delivers daily from sin's *power*.

c. **Glorification** (entering heaven) will

deliver us from sin's *presence*.

**This means that (the other way around...):**

a. God has saved us from  
sin's *penalty* - **JUSTIFICATION.**

b. God is saving us from  
sin's *power* - **SANCTIFICATION.**

c. God will save us from  
sin's *presence* - **GLORIFICATION.**

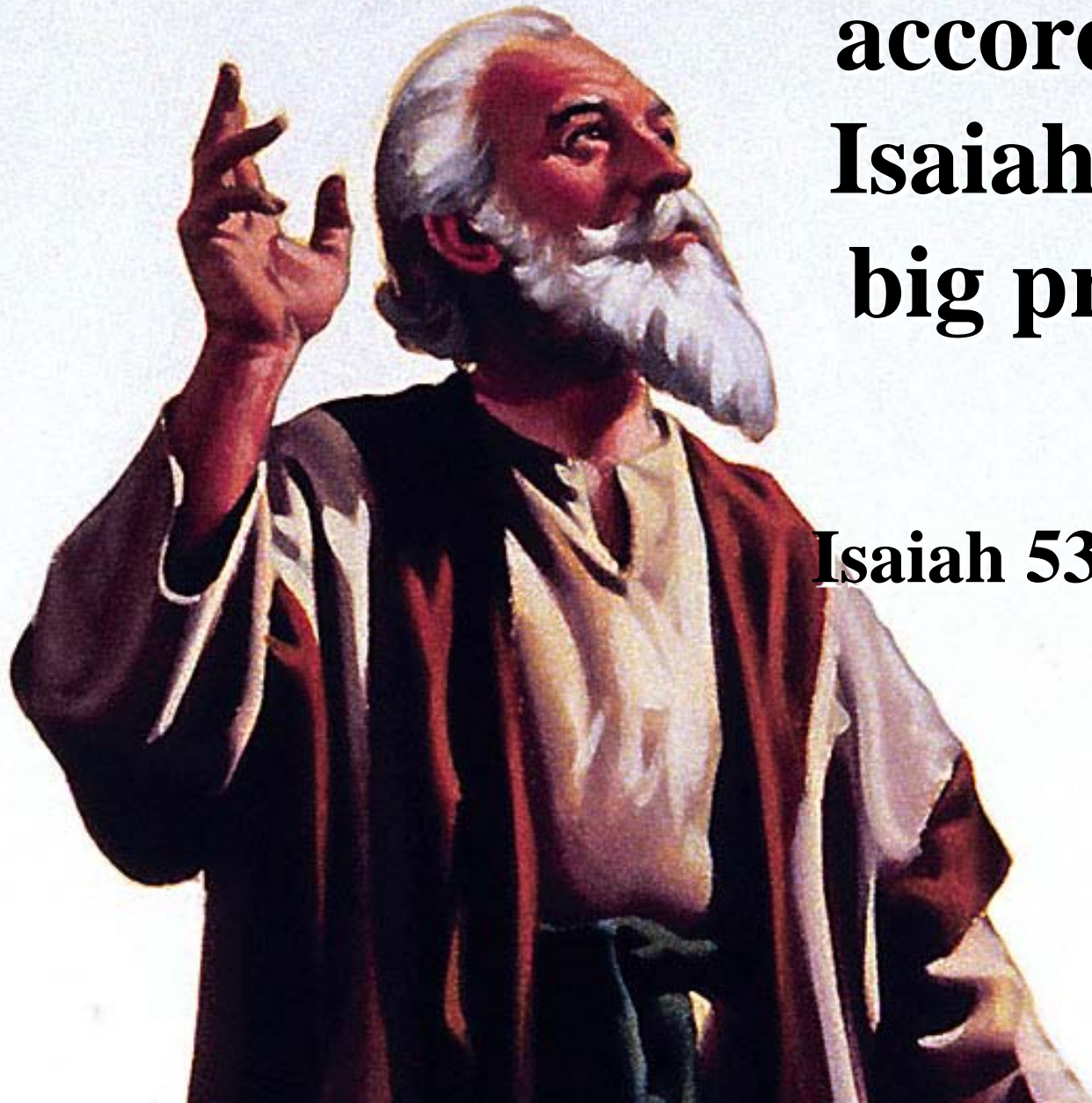




**14. What,
