





SALVATION:

How the Bible presents it:

- a. Justification is conversion. It delivers us from sin's *penalty*.
- b. Sanctification is victorious living. It delivers daily from sin's *power*.
- c. Glorification (entering heaven) will deliver us from sin's *presence*.

This means that (the other way around...):

a. God has saved us from sin's *penalty* - JUSTIFICATION.


b. God is saving us from sin's *power* - **SANCTIFICATION**.


c. God will save us from sin's presence - GLORIFICATION.
